

# Day Use & Annual Pass Club Member Agreement



## Guest Orientation

### No Trespassing:

REGISTER AT OFFICE UPON ARRIVAL

**Day Use Hours:** From 8:00 am until 10:00 pm

### Office Hours:

Mon – Sat 9AM – 5PM, extended Fri til 9PM  
Closed Sunday  
Call phone number posted on door when closed  
Host number: 352-650-8183  
Courtesy phone on front porch if needed

### Vehicles:

Gate—one vehicle at a time, no “tailgating”  
10 MPH speed limit  
Park in designated areas only, do not drive off roads  
Keep internal travel to a minimum  
Watch out for children  
Bikes, skateboards, etc are not allowed on the entrance hill  
ATV's are prohibited.

### Clothing:

Dress in a way that does not distract others from God-focus  
Shirt / blouse to be worn around the grounds  
Shoes are recommended for safety

### Smoking:

No smoking inside or within 20' of any and all buildings  
No smoking near other non-smoking guests  
Cigarettes are to be extinguished and put in outside trash

### No Alcoholic Beverages, Illegal Drugs, Firearms or Fireworks of any kind:

Guests should report any observed violation  
Violators of this rule will be asked to leave immediately.  
There are no exceptions to this rule.

### Pets are prohibited:

No pets are allowed for the safety of guests and the pet

### Golf Carts:

Do not touch Lakewood's golf carts.  
Use personal or rented carts safely.

### Noise:

Amplified devices may not be used outside at public or residence areas

### WiFi:

May be available—ask for details

### Activities & Equipment: Open 8 AM to 10:45 PM

Check for an 'exclusive use' schedule  
See posted rules and instructions in the activities center  
Most equipment located in open lockers outside near courts  
Some equipment stays at the game – Ex: Human Foosball, 4 sq  
Return equipment to proper storage location when not in use  
Use the right equipment for the right game  
Some equipment requires sign-out and deposit  
Ask for assistance if anything is needed  
Report breakage so it can be quickly repaired  
Treat the areas and equipment gently  
Dispose of all trash

### Pool: Open 10 AM to 10 PM

Modest swimwear required (no bikinis or Speedos)  
No lifeguard on duty – you are responsible for your safety  
Under 16 must not enter area without adult (18+) supervision  
Observe all posted rules  
Keep water clean – shower off, no face paint, oils, etc  
No running, pushing, diving, or rough play  
Keep furniture 3' from pool perimeter  
No food in pool area  
No water balloons in pool area  
Do not play with safety equipment

### Lakefront: Open 8 AM to Dusk

Canoes and boats available 8 AM to dusk  
Everyone must wear a life vest  
Life vests, paddles, and oars are located in the boathouse  
No more than 3 to a canoe or boat  
One of the 3 persons must be 16 or older  
Watch out for alligators and snakes around lake areas  
2-Hour limit on usage of canoes and boats  
Return canoes and boats to shore (upside down)  
Return life vests, paddles, and oars to boathouse  
If you get muddy, wash off at an outdoor hose or faucet  
Do not bring mud into buildings or the pool area

### Lakewood Café: Hours vary. Ask for details.

Scheduled times change weekly  
Go directly to the kitchen serving line for service  
Pay before leaving the dining room  
Tips are not expected but if given go to all team members

### Camp Store, Snak Shak, Ice, & Drinks

Store located in the office building off the main lobby—open during office hours  
Snak Shak located in activity center—open by appointment or scheduled times  
Ice is available at the store or dining hall when open or call host 352-650-8183  
Drink machines are available at the activity center, dining hall porch and east entrance, office porch, cabin and campground bathhouses.

**INSURANCE:** The Individual / Family represents that it has adequate insurance or other financial ability to provide for emergencies of its attendees. Neither the Family nor any attendee will look to LAKEWOOD RETREAT, or its insurer for any damages, losses or injuries.

**WAIVER OF LIABILITY:** The Individual / Family, acting for itself and as authorized agent of all attendees, represents that it has adequate insurance and accepts all risk of loss, injury or damages to the Individual / Family or any attendee. By its signature below, the Individual / Family, for itself and as authorized agent of each attendee, hereby waives all rights it may have against the Southern Mennonite Camp Association, Inc. d/b/a LAKEWOOD RETREAT, its officers, directors, employees or volunteers for any injuries, loss or damages resulting from attendance at the premises, participation in any activity at the Personal or Family Retreat, or utilization of any of the facilities of LAKEWOOD RETREAT.

**INDEMNIFICATION:** The Individual / Family, acting for itself and as authorized agent of all attendees, hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless LAKEWOOD RETREAT for any injuries or damages resulting from attendance at the premises, participation in any activity at the Personal or Family Retreat, or utilization of any of the facilities of LAKEWOOD RETREAT.

\_\_\_\_\_ **That I have the authority to accept responsibility** for all the attendees of this Personal/Family Retreat for use of recreational equipment and the facilities of LAKEWOOD RETREAT and that I accept the responsibility for replacing or paying for any damages or loss caused by any attendee of the Retreat.

\_\_\_\_\_ **That I have the authority to enforce all LAKEWOOD RETREAT policies** including:  
(1) No pets, (2) No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances, (3) No smoking in or within 20 feet of any building, (4) No foul language (5) No immodest clothing (especially bikinis), (6) No fire-arms or fireworks.

\_\_\_\_\_ **That I will provide adequate leadership for safety and effective control** including:  
(1) first aid supplies for health care, (2) available transportation to a medical facility in case of an emergency, and (3) adequate supervision in buildings and recreational areas to insure safety and a high standard of morality.
