"Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace, according to your word," Luke 2:29

While I write this letter, the world is experiencing a most unique day. Leap day - February 29. Every four years we add a day to our life in order to keep our calendar straight. We make a big deal about those born today, like the woman who has lived for 100 years, yet only celebrated 25 birth days. Stores offer special discounts 29% off, hoping to lure in customers.

I decided to do something a little different for Leap Day this year. I looked through every book of the Bible so see what if it had a chapter 2, verse 29. I was curious. Interestingly enough there were only a handful of 2:29's in the Bible. There were two that stood out to me.

In the prophet Joel, God makes an amazing promise to "pour out my Spirit" on His people. A promise that would later be fulfilled on the day of Pentecost. In Luke, the prophet Simeon has just seen the baby Jesus and realized that this child is the fulfillment of promise that he has been waiting for. Having seen the promise of God with his own eyes, he is ready to depart this world, "You are letting Your servant depart in peace."

Both of the 2:29's are a great encouragement, a reminder that our God is one who keeps His promises.

And the exercise of looking through the Bible gave me a fun way to interact with God's Word. I hope that the Spirit that God has poured upon you, keeps you curious about what is in the Bible. And I hope that we don't wait until next Leap Year to check it out. Dive into God's Word, you won't be disappointed!
