The Supreme Court is right now exploring an important case that will have significant ramifications for believers. In *Fulton vs. Philadelphia*, the highest court in the land is hearing oral arguments to determine the fate of faith-based foster care and adoption providers. In 2018, an investigative journalist informed the city's Department of Human Services that Catholic Social Services would not work with same-sex couples as foster parents, which the city considered a violation of their anti-discrimination laws. The city then demanded they change their religious practices or close down their ministry. As one of the largest foster care providers in the region, an unfavorable outcome will have devastating consequences to already at risk children.
