In one of our exciting conversations, Debbie told me that I am not a deep thinker at times.

“What?” I exclaimed. “That’s not true. I can probably think of five verses to the song ‘There’s a Hole in the Bottom of the Sea’”.

“Not like that,” she said, “I mean you don’t think using your feelings.”

“Using your feelings is not thinking, it’s feeling,” I thought. “Not only that, feelings are by definition illogical. They are feelings and they go with whatever you are feeling, which is not what I’m thinking. You have no control over them. That can be dangerous. It can lead you into somewhere you don’t want to go; like crying for no apparent reason.”

As I pondered this I started thinking how faith is a lot like feelings. Faith, too, is illogical. Faith does not act logically. Our faith is based upon what we do not see and yet believe in. When we live by faith we are not in control, God is. That can be dangerous. It can lead us to somewhere we don’t want to go, like helping the destitute or even being ridiculed or killed.

Maybe that is one of the reasons Debbie has a greater faith than I do. The poster in her room says, “Faith is not about everything turning out okay. Faith is about being okay no matter how things turn out.”

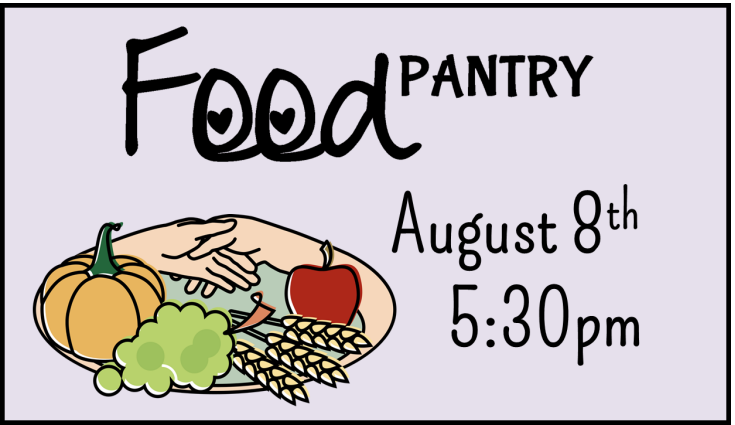

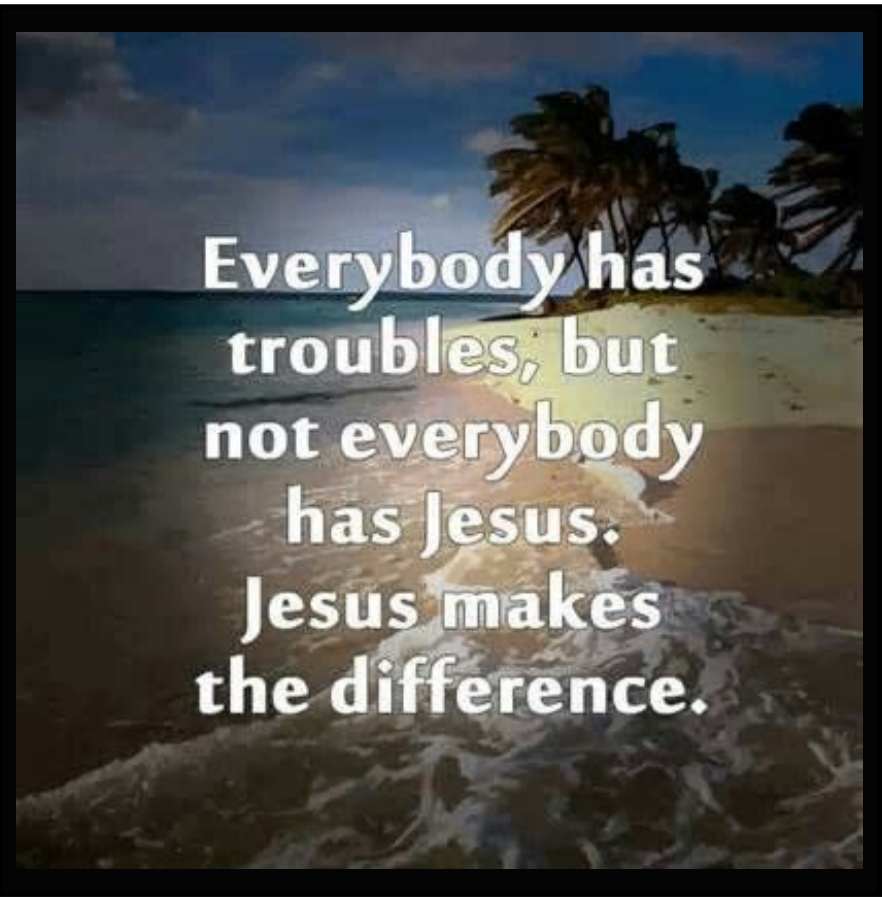
