

Information Sheet for Harvest Day King and/or Queen

Congratulations on being chosen to represent your church at Camp Dixie's Harvest Day on October 13. We'll do our best to make it a fun and memorable day for you!



Here are some answers to some commonly asked questions:

When do I need to arrive? Please be at the Camp before 11:00 a.m. If you arrive earlier to take part in the day's events, please stop by the office when you arrive to let us know you are here.

What do I wear? We will be taking photos of all King and Queen representatives so you'll want to look neat and clean. Semi-casual clothing is recommended – slacks and a collared shirt for guys; casual dress, skirt, or slacks for the ladies. *(These are suggestions only)*. Some teens prefer to wear sportswear and change clothing for the photo and festivities. We will be putting a banner on you to identify you as your church's king or queen.

What about the photos? Photos will be taken of each of you individually and together if your church has both a king and queen. We will take photos at 11:00 a.m. at scenic locations around the camp. You will receive an 8x10 individual shot.

What time do I need to be in the chapel for the Closing? This year's crowning will begin at 1:00 p.m. After lunch, go directly up to the chapel.
