

Job Description
Associate Pastor of Worship
First Baptist Church Perry

Principle Function:

The Associate Pastor of Worship will be responsible for leading, shepherding and developing a team of volunteers, designing a modern, authentic worship experience for the multi-generation members of First Baptist Church Perry. Connect people to Christ, help them mature in Him and serve Him by serving others. The Pastor will perform all duties in accordance with the teachings of God's Word and the 2000 edition of the Baptist Faith and Message.

Immediate Supervisor:

The Associate Pastor of Worship is under the direct supervision of the Senior Pastor. The church council and human resources committee may also provide direction, supervision and accountability.

Education / Skills:

Bachelor / Seminary degree preferred.
Proficiency in one or more instruments – preferably guitar and or keyboard.

Duties:

- Meets weekly with the Senior Pastor to plan and coordinate all corporate worship services.
- Plans, coordinated and oversees all praise team and tech team rehearsals.
- Responsible for all choral, instrumental, ensemble, praise team and solo music used in all services.
- Advise in matters of wedding, funeral, and special events in compliance with the facility usage policy.
- Assist with weddings, funerals and special services as needed.
- Provide direction, training and supervision to the technology team, musicians, singers and all worship / music ministry volunteers.
- Provide direction / assistance related to preschool, children's, youth and adult music programs.
- Prepare and manage the annual budget for all worship ministry needs.
- Assist with the on-going care of the congregation including home and hospital visits.
- Provide basic counseling as appropriate.
- Serve on various committees and leadership teams as needed.
- Attend weekly staff meetings, annual planning sessions, and staff retreats.
- Serve as advisor to the church council.
- Provide ministry related announcements through all communication outlets.
- Deal effectively and tactfully with church personnel, church members and the general public.
- Model the life of a dedicated Christ follower and ministry leader.

- Be willing to submit to the leadership of the Senior Pastor and perform other ministerial functions assigned by the Senior Pastor.
