Responsive Reading of Psalm 91

He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.

"Because he loves me," says the LORD, "I will rescue him;


"I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.




