

**Nationwide Youth Roundup (NYR) 2021**

Travel Dates: July 15-July 24, 2021

Location: 35 miles south of Denver, CO (924 miles from BCC), 8,000 ft. above sea level.

\*Anyone under age 12 must be accompanied by parent/guardian per Colorado State law.

\*Anyone entering 5<sup>th</sup> grade or older is able to work off up to \$50 of the cost of the trip in service hours (work days) at a rate of \$10 per hour.

**IMPORTANT INFO:**

- The goal of this trip is to provide an opportunity to connect with God at a deeper level and form deeper friendships within the body of Christ. While we will have a great time on this trip, this is not a vacation. It is a spiritual retreat. Come prepared to work hard (setting up camp, cooking food, doing dishes, fetching water, etc) and grow deeper in your relationship with Christ.
- **Deposit Due:** April 25, 2021--\$100.00 for those entering 5<sup>th</sup> grade - Adult and \$25.00 for 4 years old - those entering 4<sup>th</sup> grade—This is a non-refundable deposit to reserve your spot for the trip. The remainder of the money will be due June 20. Checks should be made out to BCC with NYR on the memo line.
- The actual cost of the trip is significantly more than what we ask people to pay. To help make NYR affordable, we will do three and possibly four fundraising/work projects. Attendance is mandatory for these work projects: 1) Work Days 2) Possible Pizza Ranch? 3) Breakfast Dinner 4) Escape Room
- If finances are a concern, let us know. At BCC, our policy is that finances will never keep people from attending a function. We ask everyone to cover the deposit. If that is still a financial obstacle, let us know.

**Other Expenses:**

- We ask the trip participants to provide food items for the Breakfast Dinner and for our trip.
- Money for food on travel days (4 days total, 2 going and 2 coming)
- Money for offering, snacks, conference merchandise (apparel, CD's)
- Money for special day trip. In the past, our fundraising has covered our free day except for souvenirs/snacks.
