## Warren's Words of Wisdom—Warren Brosi, Minister

### Who is Like the LORD?

In [Isaiah 40.18](#), the question is asked, "With whom, then, will you compare God?" Again in [Isaiah 40.25](#) "To whom will you compare me? Or who is my equal? says the Holy One?" These questions serve as the foundation for our summer series through the last part of Isaiah. Who is like the LORD?

This summer, we invite you to read through the Old Testament prophet, Isaiah. It is a longer book with 66 chapters. We will focus on what many people call the book of comfort which covers Isaiah 40-66. Sometimes called the fifth gospel, Isaiah speaks in great detail about the Servant of the LORD. Jesus fulfills many of the prophecies Isaiah spoke 700 years before the time of Jesus. During our sermons, we will explore the character of God. In Isaiah 40-43, we will see how God is Everlasting, Gentle and Holy. Then, in Isaiah 52-58, we will explore God as Suffering, Generous, and Guiding. Finally, in Isaiah 61-66, we will study how God is Compassionate, Grieving, and Renewing. I hope you will join us for worship at 10:00 a.m. on Sundays for these messages. We are confident in the words from [Isaiah 55:10–11 \(NIV\)](#),

As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.

God's word will not return empty, but will accomplish His purpose. I'm excited to see how we will grow in our understanding and passion for our God. Who is Like the LORD? No one is like our God.
