

# When I see the Blood

NLT

**Luk 22:15** Jesus said, “I have been very eager to eat this Passover meal with you before my suffering begins.

**Luk 22:16** For I tell you now that I won’t eat this meal again until its meaning is fulfilled in the Kingdom of God.”

NLT

**1Co 5:7** Get rid of the old “yeast” by removing this wicked person from among you. Then you will be like a fresh batch of dough made without yeast, which is what you really are. Christ, our Passover Lamb, has been sacrificed for us.

**1Co 5:8** So let us celebrate the festival, not with the old bread of wickedness and evil, but with the new bread of sincerity and truth.

We celebrate at the same time as passover because Jesus is our passover lamb. The the lamb in the old testament was a type and a shadow but Jesus is the reality.

NLT

**Lev 17:11** for the life of the body is in its blood. I have given you the blood on the altar to purify you, making you right with the LORD. It is the blood, given in exchange for a life, that makes purification ( or atonement ) possible.

**Gen 3:7** Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they *were* naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings.

**Gen 3:21** Also for Adam and his wife the LORD God made tunics of skin, and clothed them.

**Exo 12:1** While the Israelites were still in the land of Egypt, the LORD gave the following instructions to Moses and Aaron:

**Exo 12:2** “From now on, this month will be the first month of the year for you.

**Exo 12:3** Announce to the whole community of Israel that on the tenth day of this month each family must choose a lamb or a young goat for a sacrifice, one animal for each household.

**Exo 12:4** If a family is too small to eat a whole animal, let them share with another family in the neighborhood. Divide the animal according to the size of each family and how much they can eat.

**Exo 12:5** The animal you select must be a one-year-old male, either a sheep or a goat, with no defects.

**Exo 12:6** “Take special care of this chosen animal until the evening of the fourteenth day of this first month. Then the whole assembly of the community of Israel must slaughter their lamb or young goat at twilight.

**Exo 12:7** They are to take some of the blood and smear it on the sides and top of the doorframes of the houses where they eat the animal.

**Exo 12:8** That same night they must roast the meat over a fire and eat it along with bitter salad greens and bread made without yeast.

**Exo 12:9** Do not eat any of the meat raw or boiled in water. The whole animal—including the head, legs, and internal organs—must be roasted over a fire.

**Exo 12:10** Do not leave any of it until the next morning. Burn whatever is not eaten before morning.

**Exo 12:11** “These are your instructions for eating this meal: Be fully dressed, wear your sandals, and carry your walking stick in your hand. Eat the meal with urgency, for this is the LORD’s Passover.

## Exodus 12:2

This new beginning for them a new start in life ( they are no longer going to slaves). This was the starting of Israel spiritual worship ( who, how, when and why, they worship is being established). This was a start of a new life for them as a people and a nation.

1. This is a time of new beginnings.

2. Everyman shall take for himself a lamb. ( personal responsibility) No excuses!

- a. Get the lamb
- b. Kill the lamb
- c. Put the blood of the lamb on the door post
- d. Roast the lamb
- e. Eat the lamb
- f. Dispose of what was left of the lamb

3. Get ready ( Be fully dressed). Get prepared for what I am about to do!

**I believe this is our moment of Divine Opportunity!**

**Exo 12:21** Then Moses called all the elders of Israel together and said to them, “Go, pick out a lamb or young goat for each of your families, and slaughter the Passover animal.

**Exo 12:22** Drain the blood into a basin. Then take a bundle of hyssop branches and dip it into the blood. Brush the hyssop across the top and sides of the doorframes of your houses. And no one may go out through the door until morning.

**Exo 12:23** For the LORD will pass through the land to strike down the Egyptians. But when he sees the blood on the top and sides of the doorframe, the LORD will pass over your home. He will not permit his death angel to enter your house and strike you down.

**Exo 12:24** “Remember, these instructions are a permanent law that you and your descendants must observe forever.

**Exo 12:25** When you enter the land the LORD has promised to give you, you will continue to observe this ceremony.

4. Stay in the house

Exo 12:23 For the LORD will pass through the land to strike down the Egyptians. But when he sees the blood on the top and sides of the doorframe, the LORD will pass over your home. He will not permit his death angel to enter your house and strike you down.

God will pass over you and not allow the enemy the destroyer to touch you because of the blood!

## **The Blood is Precious**

**Pe 1:18** For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors,

**1Pe 1:19** but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.

**1Pe 1:20** He was chosen before the creation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for your sake.

**1Pe 1:21** Through him you believe in God, who raised him from the dead and glorified him, and so your faith and hope are in God.

Precious-

(of an object, substance, or resource) of great value; not to be wasted or treated carelessly.

## **The Blood is Justifying you**

**Rom 3:24** being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,

**Rom 3:25** whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed

**Col 1:19** For God in all his fullness was pleased to live in Christ,

**Col 1:20** and through him God reconciled everything to himself. He made peace with everything in heaven and on earth by means of Christ's blood on the cross.

**Col 1:21** This includes you who were once far away from God. You were his enemies, separated from him by your evil thoughts and actions.

**Col 1:22** Yet now he has reconciled you to himself through the death of Christ in his physical body. As a result, he has brought you into his own presence, and you are holy and blameless as you stand before him without a single fault.

## **The Blood Atoning you**

Lev 17:11 tells us that the blood made atonement.

**Heb 10:8** First, Christ said, “You did not want animal sacrifices or sin offerings or burnt offerings or other offerings for sin, nor were you pleased with them” (though they are required by the law of Moses).

**Heb 10:9** Then he said, “Look, I have come to do your will.” He cancels the first covenant in order to put the second into effect.

**Heb 10:10** For God’s will was for us to be made holy by the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ, once for all time.

**Heb 10:11** Under the old covenant, the priest stands and ministers before the altar day after day, offering the same sacrifices again and again, which can never take away sins.

**Heb 10:12** But our High Priest offered himself to God as a single sacrifice for sins, good for all time. Then he sat down in the place of honor at God’s right hand.

**Heb 10:13** There he waits until his enemies are humbled and made a footstool under his feet.

**Heb 10:14** For by that one offering he forever made perfect those who are being made holy.

### **The Blood Restores you**

**Eph 2:13** But now you have been united with Christ Jesus. Once you were far away from God, but now you have been brought near to him through the blood of Christ.

**Rom 5:10** For since our friendship with God was restored by the death of his Son while we were still his enemies, we will certainly be saved through the life of his Son.

**Eph 1:7** In Him we have redemption (deliverance and salvation) through His blood, the remission (forgiveness) of our offenses (shortcomings and trespasses), in accordance with the riches and the generosity of His gracious favor,

## The Blood Protects you

Ex 12:21-24

### The Blood gives you Authority

**Rev 12:11** And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

### The Blood gives you Access

**Heb 10:19** And so, dear brothers and sisters, we can boldly enter heaven's Most Holy Place because of the blood of Jesus.

**Heb 10:20** By his death, Jesus opened a new and life-giving way through the curtain into the Most Holy Place.

**Heb 10:21** And since we have a great High Priest who rules over God's house,

**Heb 10:22** let us go right into the presence of God with sincere hearts fully trusting him. For our guilty consciences have been sprinkled with Christ's blood to make us clean, and our bodies have been washed with pure water.

### The Blood Speaks for you

**Gen 4:9** Then the LORD said to Cain, "Where *is* Abel your brother?" He said, "I do not know. *Am* I my brother's keeper?"

**Gen 4:10** And He said, "What have you done? The voice of your brother's blood cries out to Me from the ground.

**Heb 12:22** But rather, you have come to Mount Zion, even to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to countless multitudes of angels in festal gathering,

**Heb 12:23** And to the church (assembly) of the Firstborn who are registered [*as citizens*] in heaven, and to the God Who is Judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous (the redeemed in heaven) who have been made perfect,

**Heb 12:24** And to Jesus, the Mediator (Go-between, Agent) of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood which speaks [*of mercy*], a better and nobler and more gracious message than the blood of Abel [*which cried out for vengeance*].
