

Life Group Questions – Assurance of God's Leading (Proverbs 3:5-6)

1. Proverbs 3:5-6 tells us to "trust in the Lord with all your heart" and "lean not on your own understanding." What area of your life is it most difficult for you to fully trust God with right now? What makes surrender in that area challenging?
2. This sermon emphasized that God primarily leads through **His Word, His Spirit, and His Providence**. Which of these three ways have you experienced most clearly in your own life? Share an example.
3. Pastor Jon said, *"The more we know God's Word, the more we learn God's heart. The more we learn God's heart, the easier it becomes to recognize God's leading."* Why do you think knowing Scripture is so foundational to discerning God's will? How can you become more intentional in letting God's Word shape your daily decisions?
4. Have you ever looked back and realized God was guiding you through circumstances you didn't understand at the time? What did that experience teach you about trusting God's providence?
5. The sermon reminded us that God usually gives enough light for the **next step**, not the entire journey. Why do you think God often leads us this way? How does taking one step of obedience at a time help deepen our relationship with Him?
6. As you leave this week's study, what is one specific step of faith or obedience you believe God is calling you to take? How can this group pray for and encourage you as you follow His leading?
