

Life Group Questions

1. What are you currently pursuing — and how do you know if it truly matters?

Scripture: “For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” — Matthew 6:21

Life Application: Take an honest look at your calendar, spending habits, or thought life this week. What do they reveal about what you value most? What’s one area where you feel called to shift your pursuit?

2. In what ways have you tied your worth to achievement, performance, or approval?

Scripture: “See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!” — 1 John 3:1

Life Application: Where do you most feel the pressure to “prove yourself”? How would your behavior change if you truly believed your identity was already secure in Christ?

3. Jesus said, “What good is it to gain the whole world yet forfeit your soul?” — What does “forfeiting your soul” look like today?

Scripture: Mark 8:36

Life Application: Have you ever chased something that left you empty even after you “got it”? What did you learn from that experience?

4. How does surrendering your success to Jesus change the way you define success?

Scripture: “I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord...” — Philippians 3:8

Life Application: What is one area of your life (career, family plans, finances, reputation) you need to re-surrender to Christ this week?

5. Jesus says, “Take up your cross and follow Me.” What does that practically look like in your daily life?

Scripture: Galatians 2:20 — “I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me...”

Life Application: What is one habit, attitude, or comfort you may need to “die to” so that Jesus can live more fully through you?

6. How does following Jesus redefine success from achievement to transformation?

Scripture: “The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness...” — Galatians 5:22-23

Life Application: If success isn’t about climbing higher but becoming more like Jesus, which “fruit of the Spirit” do you most want to grow in right now?

7. If you viewed life through the lens of eternity, what would change first?

Scripture: “Fix your eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen...” — 2 Corinthians 4:18

Life Application: What’s one decision you’re facing right now — big or small — where you need to choose what will matter forever rather than just for now?
