

Life Group Questions – Luke 12:13–21

1. Icebreaker

What's something you've collected or held onto over the years? Why do you think it's hard for people to let go of certain things?

2. Read Luke 12:13–21 together

What stands out to you most about the rich man in the parable? What do you notice about his mindset or focus?

3. Greed Is Subtle

In what ways can greed show up in our lives without us even realizing it?

How does **Jeremiah 17:9** and **Ecclesiastes 5:10** help us understand why this is so dangerous?

4. Misplaced Trust

Read **Proverbs 11:28** and **1 Timothy 6:17**.

What are some practical ways we can tell if we are trusting in our resources instead of trusting in God?

5. Heart Check

The rich man said “my crops, my barns, my plans.”

Where do you see a similar mindset creeping into your own life?

6. Eternal Perspective

Read **Matthew 6:19–21** and **Luke 12:21**.

What does it practically look like to be “rich toward God” in everyday life?

7. Weekly Challenge: Open Hands

This week's challenge is to live with open hands.

What is one specific thing (time, money, control, etc.) you feel God prompting you to release or trust Him with this week?

How can this group encourage or hold you accountable in that?
