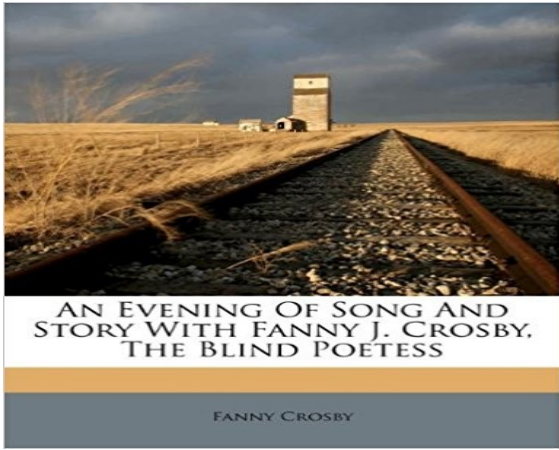



HER Missions:

THESE ARE THE FACTS:

Baptisms in the Southern Baptist Convention are at their lowest level since 1946.

Ninety Five percent of church members never lead a single person to faith in Christ.

At best, only a third of church members attend church on any given Sunday in the average Southern Baptist Church.

Among Generaton Z (those born 1999-2015), the percentage that identifies as atheist is double that of the rest of the U.S. population.

Of the 6.5 million people who live in Tennessee, at least 3.5 million have no relationship with Jesus Christ. Membership in Southern Baptist Churches has declined 9 years in a row, down from over 16 million to around 15 million.

A former Southern Baptist Convention President said, "we are living in an anti-institutional, anti-church age, where people are opting out of organized religious activities."

That is the nation we find ourselves living in. So, what is the church to do?

The great need of our day is REVIVAL. A genuine movement of God in which men and women, boys and girls encounter the power of the gospel of Jesus Christ and are moved to a life changing commitment to the Savior.

Here at SRBC, we have a series of REVIVAL meetings scheduled from April 8-11. Phil Glisson will be our speaker for the week. Sunday services are at the regular times and Monday-Wednesday the services begin at 6:30. I pray that we will have authentic Revival. For that to happen, EVERY MEMBER OF SRBC must make a concerted effort to pray for each service, to attend each service, and to invite friends and family who do not know Christ to each service.

I ask each of you to block these days off on your calendar and be faithful to Christ by seeking REVIVAL. Our county needs it. Our state needs it. Our nation needs it. And we at SRBC need it. My prayer is that God will send a great REVIVAL, and that it will begin in me!
