TEMPORARY GUIDELINES

Praise God! We will have worship service IN THE AUDITORIUM this week. We are excited about being “back to the building” together to worship our Lord. But we want to make sure it is a safe experience for everyone. We will follow this Sunday procedure for the immediate future, but will constantly be monitoring updates from the Governor. Here are the details:

- First of all: if you are not feeling well we ask you to stay home and recover. If you are not comfortable in a “group” environment yet, please feel free to stay home. The worship will continue to be online as always.
- Prior to the service, all surfaces will be disinfected and hand sanitizer will be readily available and encouraged to be used.
- We will have one service at **10:00AM (doors open at 9:45, please no early arrivals)**
- Feel free to wear a mask
- Our greeter(s) will open door for you
- The lobby will be set up for one way (enter through one set of doors and exit through the opposite – see signs)
- Hand sanitizer, communion (self-contained) and bulletins will be available on tables as you walk into lobby
- Parents please also grab an activity bag for each child and drop off on table when exiting lobby after service (items will be disinfected for each Sunday’s use)
- Please proceed to the auditorium rather than gathering in the lobby
- In the auditorium, tables will be set up for family units and sets of chairs available for others (set up 6 feet apart for social distancing). If more chairs are needed for your group, someone will be available to assist you
- Offerings can be dropped in the box provided either upon entering or exiting the lobby
- Even though we love each other, we will avoid touching, handshaking or hugging
- Children will sit with family (Children’s programming to resume as soon as we can do so, safely)
