Projects benefit MCC Winter Warm Up and NE MCC Relief Sale. The next Sewing Day is **Tuesday, January 27 from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.** and February dates are **Tuesday, February 10 and February 24.** Come as your schedule allows. Lunch served at Noon. You are welcome to come just for Lunch and Fellowship. Winter Sewing days are the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of January, February and March.

Last year, MCC shipped 39,616 comforters to communities in Canada, Malawi, Palestine (Gaza), Ukraine, the U.S. (including Puerto Rico) and Zambia.

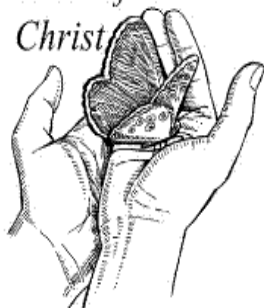

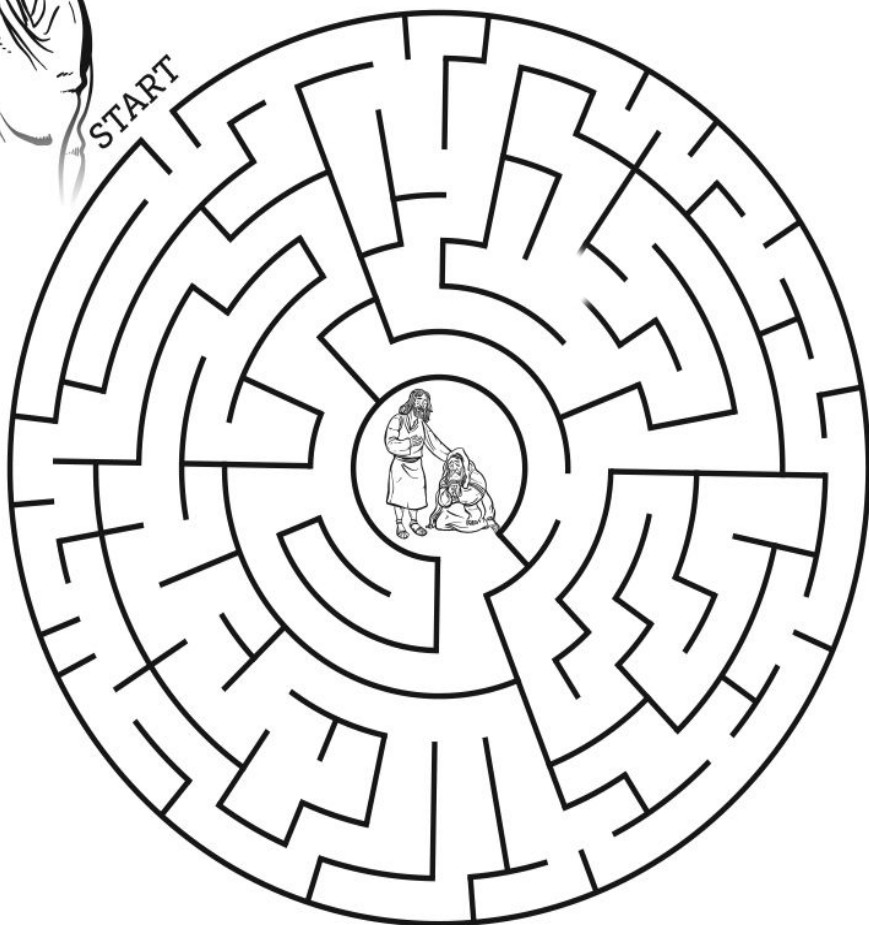
