New Library Books

'Women Who Risk', by Tom and JoAnn Doyle, "Women Who Risk" is a collection of riveting real-life stories that takes you deep in the heart of the Muslim world. Despite enormous risks to themselves, these former Muslim women are new followers of Jesus and are influencing their families and bringing others to faith in Christ.

'The Prince of Egypt', for children explores the story of Moses and helps answer questions children may have regarding God and faith such as what makes Moses a great hero, what miracles happen in the story and how did Moses find out he was not born to Egyptian royalty but rather to Hebrew slaves. The questions in the back of the book help lead a family discussion and invites children to ask their own.

We're already a month into our 4th school year!

We were excited to come back to Thailand during rainy season, our favorite! Our July routine was: daily morning walk and quiet times, Thai lesson, lunch, work on school prep/random errands that have been put off until summer, then some sort of activity with community...lots of tennis, meals, and games nights!

Our school is on a different schedule than Thai schools so the girls were in school sadly during our break... but we were able to see them when we went on weekends and had them over to our house for a movie night! Pray for this season of the girls getting older, that we would be bold and intentional to share with them (and that Katelyn can figure out a set time with the oldest daughter).

At the end of July, our friends came to visit which was such good time together sharing our world with them here in Thailand. Callie was able to stay into the school year a bit which was a really sweet time to live life together again and such a huge help for Katelyn in deep cleaning her moldy, messy classroom and getting organized for the new year!

This school year, Jaden is teaching 9th and 10th world history, an optional (elective) world history for combined 11th and 12th grade, as well as one class to guide a group of students in homework.

Katelyn is teaching elementary and secondary art classes, and this year started helping 2 elementary band classes and trumpet lessons!

Both of us, together, teach 2 classes of volleyball elective to boys 7th-12th grade as well.

It was a great start to the year...we loved getting to see students again and start to settle into our new schedules.

We will explain a bit of how we do discipleship here to help give you a picture of what this time looks like so you can better know how to pray for us, these students, and this time.

Katelyn will meet in her classroom during this quarter with two girls Wednesday lunches, 1 girl Thursday after school, and 2 other girls Friday lunches. Katelyn teaches a lesson from scripture to the girls that she's prepared before-hand. After reading the scripture, praying, expositing the word and teaching, then praying again...Katelyn asks the girls what they took away from the scripture-they talk more about it and about their spiritual lives as remaining time allows!

For the friend who she disciples from church, they do the same process at our house on Fridays after school while Jaden plays with her nephew who she is taking care of. After, we all eat together, play games and sometimes invite other church friends over for games altogether.

Jaden uses the same process but teaches one (new disciple) on Fridays at lunch and then meets with a Thai student (the same one we met through our old Thai teacher) usually Saturday mornings.

He plans to ask a non-believing Thai student from our school to meet and learn Bible-please pray for this opportunity!
