Food insecurity in York County

Blue Valley Community Action has seen a sharp rise in need for food in York County. Henderson Ministerial Pastors (Bethesda, FEBC and Living Hope) met together with Lisa Epp who works for Blue Valley out of York. She offered pastors resources and shared about some of the most effective ways to provide support to anyone who may struggle with food needs. If you would like to help, consider these following ways of getting involved:

- **Salvation Army Bell Ringing in York.** Did you know that 90% of the money donated in the red buckets in York during the holiday season is donated to Blue Valley, which serves York County? It is fun to bundle up and ring bells with friends or family for an hour to thank those donating to support local food needs. Oh and you can donate this way too! If you

are interested in bell ringing give your contact information to the church office and someone from Blue Valley will be in touch.

- **Help the Henderson Ministerial Buy a Cow!** The ministerial will match any donations up to \$1,000 to help buy a cow for the food bank. Blue Valley is in need of meat donations and already have the processing fees donated. So your donations to the Henderson Ministerial Association will be more than doubled. So our question to you is, "Where's the beef?" Checks written out to the Henderson Ministerial Association can be given to any of the pastors at Bethesda, FEBC or Living Hope.
- If you know of someone who may be in need of food, please contact one of the ministerial pastors. There is a food available:
 - Blue Valley in York hosts a food pantry once a month, which participants will need to provide contact information to participate.
 - Blue Valley also hosts the Feeding America Program Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:30-10 a.m. You may pick up bakery items, bread, eggs and many other items.
 - The York Mission also provides a food basket once a month if you attend a chapel service. Sign up for a Thanksgiving Basket before November 21. Contact the Hope Gospel Rescue Mission at 402-362-0127.
 - The Henderson Ministerial will also be funding vouchers for Blue Valley to give out for milk at the Henderson Pharmacy. You may find them at Blue Valley in York.

MCC Meat Canner Volunteers Needed

November 21, 22, 24 & 25: Every year MCC's Mobile Meat Canner travels across the United States and Canada meeting volunteers who prepare cans of turkey, beef, chicken, and pork to be sent around the world. Over 30,000 people a year volunteer to fill, weigh, wash and label every can. This year, the canner will be coming to Bethesda Mennonite Church November 21, 22, 24 and 25, 2025.

Set up for the canner is scheduled for Thursday, November 20 time TBD, and we could use some assistance with set up.

Workers for the canner truck will be needed starting Friday at 6 a.m. and then throughout the day for Friday and Saturday, Sunday we will be off, and then Monday and Tuesday. The plan this year is to can four rounds of meat per day, compared to the five rounds we usually do, so we should be finished earlier in the day compared to previous years. We also need people to grind meat, make boxes, dry cans, and move cans to the truck. We have jobs for people of all ages, and you can come and go as you please. Please join us for this rewarding and fun project.

AMBS Online Short Courses

Have you ever considered taking a course at AMBS but enrolling and learning on campus was not an option for you? Did you know that AMBS offers online short courses. This is just one available for 2026. "Understanding Anabaptist Approaches to Scripture: What's Different and Why?" taught by Laura Brennenman-Fullwood, PhD, and David Cramer, PhD.

In the 16th century, Anabaptists approached Scripture in ways that were both similar to and different from Catholics and other Protestants. This course will seek to understand those similarities and differences in light of today. What historical and theological developments in the centuries since the 16th

century have influenced today's Mennonites more profoundly than did the Reformation?

Students read assigned materials and complete short assignments, writing in an online discussion forum on their own time to meet assignment deadlines. Includes an optional video conference meeting with professors each week of the course, also recorded for participants to watch at their convenience.

The course will be offered January 28 through March 10, 2026. The early registration deadline is January 7, 2026 and the cost is \$300. The final registration deadline is January 21, 2026 and the cost is \$350. Participants should expect to pay for one or two textbooks.

Messiah Chorus Rehearsals

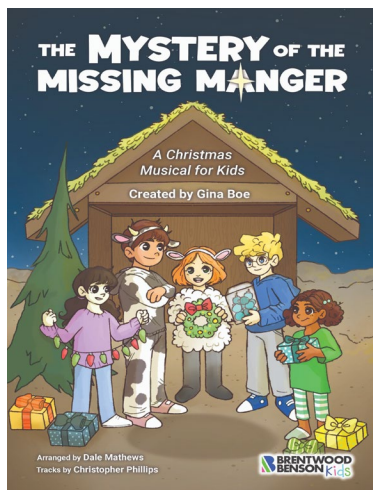

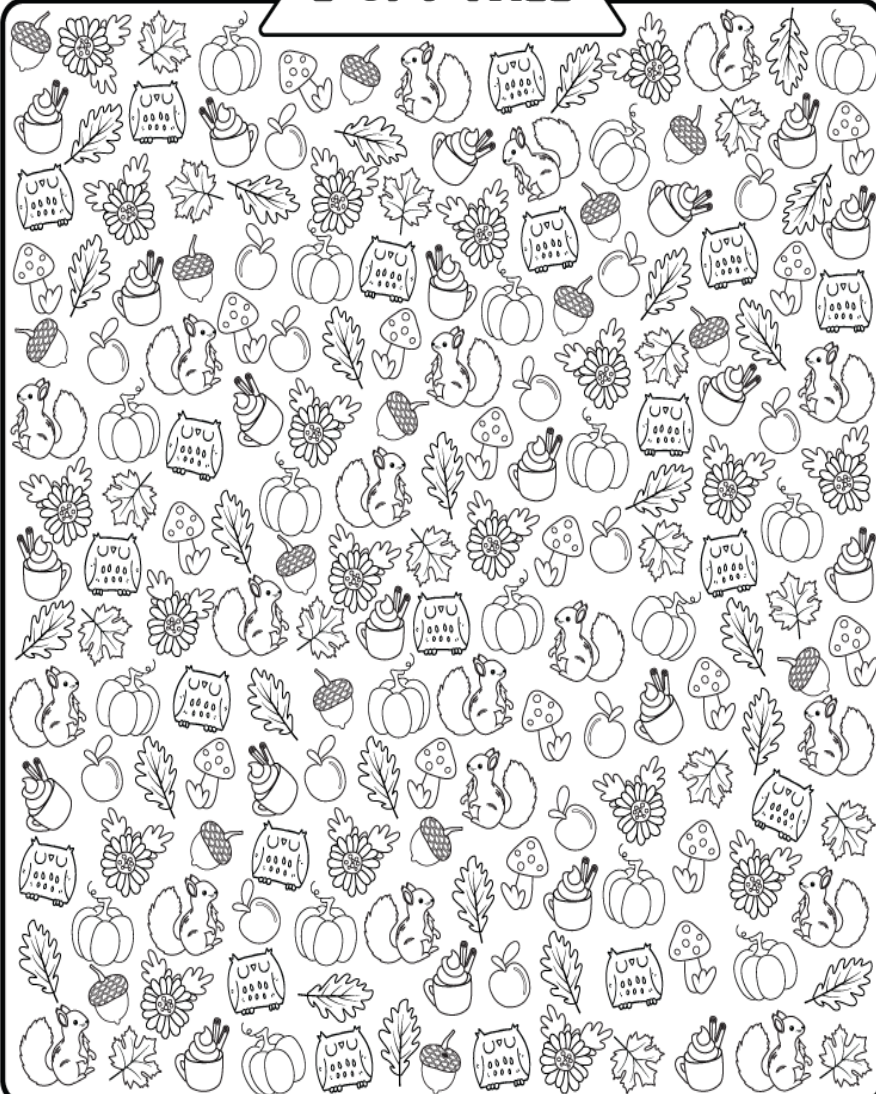
