Amazea!

The scriptures for this year's Advent Series, "Be Amazed!" speak of dry bones, a fiery furnace, a mystic's monologue, and the birth and adult ministry of Christ. Together, these scriptures have a common theme, and that is "they are amazing!" In each of them, there is a common thread of God acting in powerful and astonishing ways. The response seen in many of these passages is that of awe. We are encouraged to be amazed! As we journey together through Advent, we pray that you will in your own unique ways find wonder in the work that God has done and is currently doing in your lives and in our midst.

Imagine stepping into a blazing furnace with Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in a trial by fire, trusting God with your life. Although today's trials seem less terrifying, they are still trials—stories of injustice, poverty, and tragedy from our lives, communities, and the larger world. At the beginning of Advent, as daylight diminishes and we wonder how long the night will last, we also tell amazing stories of hope, stories of a God who saves so that we may emerge singing "Sometimes a Light Surprises" (Voices Together 618, verse 4):

Though all the fields should wither, nor flocks nor herds be there, yet God, the same abiding, through praise shall tune my voice, for while in love confiding I cannot but rejoice.
