



Nebraska Mennonite Relief Sale

2021 ONLINE MCC SALE AUCTION – GOAL \$200,000

In light of ongoing health concerns related to COVID-19, the Board of Directors has been determined the 2021 Nebraska MCC Relief Sale will be an online auction. We understand this won't be everyone's preference, however we feel this decision best protects our volunteers and communities. We would like everyone to know that we love the community and fellowship that the Nebraska Mennonite Relief Sale brings, but our primary goal is to raise funds to support the missions of Mennonite Central Committee, and an online auction can accomplish that!

HYGIENE KITS

We are encouraging churches to make Hygiene Kits and are hoping to have 250 total kits.

1 adult toothbrush (in manufacturer's packing)

1 large bar soap (leave in wrapper)

1 nail clipper (good quality)

1 hand towel (medium weight, dark or bright colors)

1 wide tooth comb (6-8 inches)

Items may be put in a gallon sized plastic bag and delivered to Fellowship Hall.

HOG AUCTION

Every year, freshly processed pork is donated to the sale to be used at the pancake breakfast and pork sandwich meals and sold in the priced foods booth. Since those meals will not be taking place this year, that pork is being made available for purchase in an auction format.

Hogs are being auctioned in 1/2 hog packages and will be processed and ready for pickup on March 26, 2021, from Henderson Meat Processors.

*Processing fee is not included in auction price.

ACTIVE BIDDING

On March 13, the hog auction will conclude with the first item closing at 6:00 p.m. Bidders can check out items and update bids throughout the day.

GENERAL/QUILT AUCTION

All items that are donated to the sale will be sold in one online auction. Items that have typically been sold at the Nebraska Mennonite Relief Sale include quilts and comforters, agriculture related items, tools,

handmade items, quiet books, themed baskets, home decor items, furniture and other craft related items. We hope to see similar items this year on the online auction.

PRE-BIDDING

Starting on March 13, items will be available to view on the auction website. At this time, bidders can place pre-bids by setting up maximum bidding preferences on items they are interested in.

ACTIVE BIDDING

On March 27, the auction will conclude with the first item closing at 9:00 a.m. Bidders can check out items and update bids up until the closing time on each item.

- Meat purchased from the hog auction must be picked up from Henderson Meat Processors between the afternoon of March 26 and the morning of March 29.

SATURDAY, March 27, 2021

- Quilt and general auction concludes.
- Auction and t-shirt orders are delivered to churches for distribution. Contact your church representative for instructions on pickup.

MONDAY, March 29, 2021

- Final day to pick up meat purchased at hog auction from Henderson Meat Processors.
