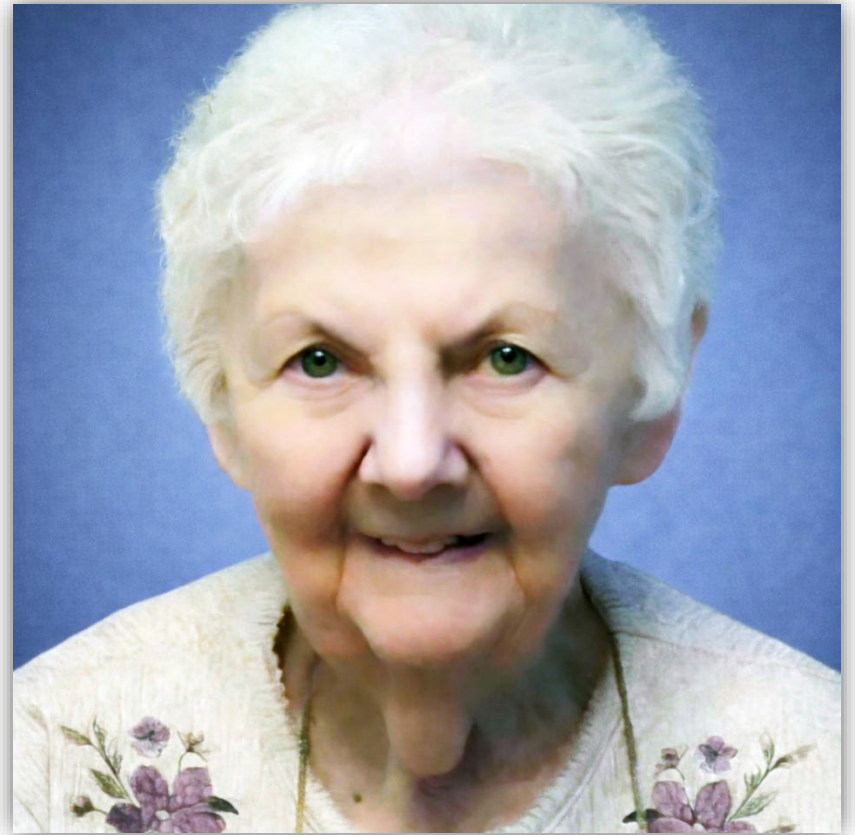
CELEBRATION OF LIFE
