CELEBRATION OF LIFE

Rick L. Vaught, age 68 of Henderson, NE died on Tuesday September 30, 2025 in Henderson. He was born on August 26, 1957 to David and Beverly (Ohnesorge) Vaught in York. As a child, Rick's family lived in Geneva, Exeter, Stromsburg, and Silver Creek before moving to Henderson in 1968. Rick was confirmed at the United Lutheran Church in Hampton and eventually became a member of the Bethesda Mennonite Church in Henderson.

He was united in marriage to Cheryl Ann Zastrow on October 10, 1981 at the Emmanuel Lutheran Church in York. On February 12, 1984, their only child, Chelsea Ann, was born. Rick was incredibly proud of Chelsea and enjoyed attending whatever it was that she was involved with.

After retiring from Coop in 2012, Rick opened Rick's Tire and Auto which he along with Cheryl owned and operated until his death. Not only was Rick known for the work he did, but he had a unique way to build friendships with his customers.

Rick also enjoyed collecting various items and loved to go to auctions and garage sales where in addition to finding good deals he cherished the opportunity to make connections with people. He had an appreciation for old cars and trucks - especially his red 1967 Chevelle and his old Chevy pickup that was known as "The Sport."

He is survived by his wife of 43 years, Cheryl Vaught of Henderson; daughter Chelsea Vaught of Henderson; siblings: David K.
