A Home for Everyone

At our Newcomers Lunch on Sunday we had 31 guests including 10 children. It was a wonderful time discovering who people are and hearing how they had come to be with us that Sunday. It was a reminder for me that the Lord wants us to love people and to enjoy spending time with them.

Many years ago I recall an elderly woman asking me, "Andrew, what can I do to help PBC?" (Since she could barely walk, couldn't drive and had very little money). I suggested two things:

- 1. **Welcome everyone who comes.** People come looking for God, looking for help, looking for company, looking for worship all kinds of reasons helping them to feel like this is a family they could belong to might just change their lives.
- 2. **Pray.** Pray for our church. Pray for our people. Pray for people to put roots down. Pray for God's will to be done. Pray that each of us, whether old or new to PBC, will thrive and grow through the relationships we build.

3. **Take them with you.** Invite others and show hospitality. Are you going out for coffee with old friends? Add one new. Are you heading to a small group? Ask

Nowadays I would probably add a third one for her -

- someone else if they would like to come? Found something good. Share the news or experience with them.
- "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you," Jesus said.
