Health Check

We all go to the Doctor for a health check in the winter. What about an emotional health check as well? Here is a checklist:

1. How do I feel?

Examine and own your own feelings. Be real.

2. How do I let out inner pressure?

Find a way to vent these, e.g. prayer, a friend, art, journal...

3. What do I truly value?

Try and name what's important to you and identify your 'points of joy' so you can create more of these in the near future.

4. How is my body really doing?

What would I recommend to me to improve my vitals, e.g. sleep, exercise, social connection, etc.

5. What am I looking forward to in the future?

What's in my forward vision that might excite and inspire me? What can I plan as spring and summer comes?

Why not pick just one aspect, make time in your week to address and build into this area? Then discuss it with a family member or friend and lock it in.
