

When the first Romans became Christians out of Greco-Roman culture, they immediately recognised that there are a number of key character qualities that are foundational to our success in life and help us to become more like Jesus. These are called Virtues.

The first four -Wisdom, Self Discipline, Justice, and Courage -are called the Cardinal Virtues because they are like the hinges on a door. Every other character quality depends upon these, and we can develop these qualities in and for ourselves, with the Holy Spirit's help.

The other three virtues they identified were Faith, Hope and Love, and according to tradition only the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit.

Over the summer we are focusing upon the four cardinal or key qualities and noting the mega-difference they make in our lives.

We hope these will set you up for a great start to the New Year.

FIRE EVACUATION SCHEME



- Anyone who discovers a fire must shout an alert to other people in the building.
- Staff, leaders and building keyholders are being trained to undertake the duty of a Fire Warden.
- Evacuating people from the building always takes priority over phoning the fire service or fighting the fire.
- Parents will be advised how children will be evacuated when they are in another part of the building.
- If you need assistance to exit the building wait for people to help you when others have left.
- We no longer have trial fire evacuations - if a warning is shouted or the alarm sounds treat it as a real emergency.

CHURCH PICNIC SATURDAY 24 JANUARY 2026


