



### **Weeks 1-6: Creation – God's Good Design and Our Purpose**

1. **Genesis 1:1** In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.
2. **Genesis 1:27** So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.
3. **Psalm 139:14** I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well.
4. **Psalm 8:3-4** When I look at your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is man that you are mindful of him, and the son of man that you care for him?
5. **Genesis 2:3** So God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it God rested from all his work that he had done in creation.
6. **Psalm 19:1** The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.

### **Weeks 7-12: The Fall – Sin's Entrance and the First Promise of Hope**

7. **Genesis 3:6** So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was to be desired to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate, and she also gave some to her husband who was with her, and he ate.
8. **Romans 3:23** for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
9. **Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
10. **Genesis 3:15** I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel.
11. **Psalm 51:5** Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me.
12. **Isaiah 53:6** All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

### **Weeks 13-22: God's Promises and People – God's Covenants and Faithful Pursuit**

13. **Genesis 12:2-3** And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.
14. **Genesis 15:6** And he believed the Lord, and he counted it to him as righteousness.
15. **Exodus 20:2** I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.



16. **Deuteronomy 6:5** You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.
17. **2 Samuel 7:16** And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.
18. **Psalm 23:1** The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.
19. **Jeremiah 29:11** For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.
20. **Jeremiah 31:33** For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.
21. **Ezekiel 36:26** And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.
22. **Isaiah 40:31** but they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.

### **Weeks 23-35: Jesus Christ – The Fulfillment of Promised Redemption**

23. **Isaiah 9:6** For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
24. **Luke 2:11** For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.
25. **John 1:14** And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.
26. **John 3:16** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.
27. **Isaiah 53:5** But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.
28. **Romans 5:8** but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
29. **1 Corinthians 15:3-4** For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.
30. **John 14:6** Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”
31. **Colossians 3:2-3** Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.



32. **Romans 10:9** because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.
33. **Titus 3:5** he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit.
34. **John 16:33** I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.
35. **Hebrews 11:1** Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

**Weeks 36-45: God's People - The Church, New Life, Faith, and Trust in God**

36. **2 Corinthians 5:17** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.
37. **2 Corinthians 3:18** And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.
38. **Philippians 4:6-7** do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
39. **Romans 8:28** And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.
40. **Proverbs 3:5-6** Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.
41. **Joshua 1:9** Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.
42. **Psalm 46:1** God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.
43. **1 Peter 5:6-7** Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.
44. **Lamentations 3:22-23** The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.
45. **Romans 8:38-39** For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**Weeks 46-52: New Creation – Our Eternal Hope and Confidence**

46. **Isaiah 65:17** For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth, and the former things shall not be remembered or come into mind

47. **2 Peter 3:13** But according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.
48. **Revelation 21:1** Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more.
49. **Revelation 21:4** He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.
50. **1 Thessalonians 4:16-17** For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord.
51. **Revelation 22:12-13** Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense with me, to repay each one for what he has done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end.
52. **Revelation 22:20** He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!
