Super Bowl 58 is Coming Soon!

As I watched the games this weekend, I began to think of the lessons that can be learned from sports. All year long these teams have practiced and persevered to get to the playoffs. Their goal is to win the big game – the Super Bowl. But only two teams will make it and only one will be the Champion. Paul wrote to the Corinthian church: "Every man who strives in the games exercises self-control in all things. Now they do it to receive a corruptible crown, but we an incorruptible. I therefore run like that, as not uncertainly. I fight like that, as not beating the air, but I beat my body and bring it into submission, for fear that by any means, that after I have preached to others, I myself should be rejected." (I Corinthians 9:25-27)

The apostle knew that life was like a competitive game, and it took passion and discipline. He desired to win the crown and not be disqualified. As I watched the games and thought about the upcoming Super Bowl and what Paul wrote, it became evident that there are some important principles to learn.

- 1. Winning requires discipline! Think about all the self-discipline involved in diet, workouts, exercise, and activities that must happen to be the best athlete. Lack of discipline disqualifies many athletes. They become out of shape or get into trouble and lose the privilege and edge required to be a champion. There is also discipline in the game because the rules matter. The NFL has referees who work hard to assure that everyone plays by the rules. Rules about conduct and procedure and boundaries and appropriate hits and staying onside. Breaking the rules can cost the game. Discipline is essential.
- 2. Passion pushes through the pain! Sports can be tough. It involves hitting and pushing and falling and smashing. Things bruise and break; things twist and swell. But to win, the top athletes push through. They have passion that will not quit. They endure and are determined to play through the pain to the end.
- 3. Leadership makes a difference! From the coaches to the key players, leaders encourage and challenge and focus others on the plan. Having a game plan changes everything. The team with the best plan and the ability to be prepared and make adjustments wins most of the time. Sure, crazy things happen, but leadership on and off the field changes everything. Watching a quarterback rally and challenge the team is exciting. Seeing that key defensive player motivate others to make a play and take a stand that stops the opponent is thrilling. People rise to the level to which they are challenged. Leadership matters and having a great plan determines the outcome.

Put these three lessons together and think about the Christian life. Jesus called His disciples to come and follow Him. Following Jesus requires discipline, that is why we are called disciples. Our lives are ordered by self-control that falls in line with Jesus. Life can be tough, but the true follower doesn't give in or give up. True disciples push through the pain by keeping their eyes on Jesus, who gave us the plan of salvation in His Word, and the plan for living life until He returns. He is with us, and He leads us as a Good Shepherd.

As you watch the next few weeks of football leading up to Super Bowl 58, remember the lessons that make you a champion in living for Jesus.
