Travel Dates & Transportation

Monday, March 11 through Friday, March 15. Church vans will transport the team from FBC to Fort Worth on Monday, March 11, to project sites during the week, and back to FBC Stephenville on Friday, March 15.

Trip Cost

The total cost for LaunchBox is \$250 which includes all meals & lodging. Each person receives a scholarship from FBC (15% of the trip cost). The total cost to students is **\$213**.

Packing & Lodging

Students will stay in a church building with a shower trailer on site. Students will need bring a sleeping bag and/or air mattress. Students can bring one bag for clothing, etc. and a backpack.

What is Launch Box?

Launch Box is a mission experience with iGo Global, designed to allow students to engage some of the least-reached peoples, while receiving quality training that will launch them into a life of mission back in their hometown. The experience is designed to gives students quality training, as well as opportunities to serve strategically by helping the local church reach international immigrants and refugees.

All of the work the students do is connected to ongoing ministries among the refugee communities in Fort Worth. We will work closely with Normandale Baptist, and their ministry among the refugee community. They host worship services in several different languages led by refugees, and have seen many refugees come to faith and join their church. We will also work with World Relief, a non-profit organization that works directly with the US government in refugee resettlements to help refugees find jobs, learn English, set up their apartments, get drivers' licenses, go shopping, and more. Everything that the students do at Launch Box is part of a larger, long-term strategy to reach and provide assistance to refugees.

What will we do?

The primary mission activity will be outreach to immigrants and refugees in Fort Worth. There are several local apartment complexes that house refugees who have resettled in the United States. Some projects during the week may include:

- Prayer walking
- Hosting community events & games
- Leading Backyard Bible Clubs
- Building relationships & share the gospel
- Setting up apartments for refugees who have not arrived yet

Students will also participate in training to help them understand that God calls us to a life of missional engagement rather than just going on mission trips. The training, developed by missionaries serving all over the world, will focus on plowing, sowing, reaping and vintaging (discipleship) to help students understand and embrace their role in making disciples. Each day students will engage in: evangelism training, refugee ministry, cultural awareness training, and evening Worship & Teaching.

Additional Things

- This is an excellent opportunity for those who have never gone on a mission trip and those with previous mission trip experience.
- By partnering with iGo Global, students will have an international missions experience (serving and sharing the gospel with people from all over the world), while right here in Texas.
- Our prayer for the week is that the students will use the training they receive to become more confident in making disciples in Stephenville, and will spark in them a passion for evangelism and missions.
- We will have a Mission Team meeting in February or March. All students (and parents) going on this trip, must attend this meeting.
- Packing list, additional trip information, and instructions will be available at the trip meeting.
