Love is...Patient

My final Pepperdine report is on the keynote presented by Taylor Walling. He reminded us that there are seasons when following Jesus feels wonderfully clear. We know what we believe, where we are going, and perhaps even what God is doing. And then the fog rolls in.

Life doesn’t unfold the way we expected. Things we once understood with certainty suddenly become harder to see. Sometimes the distance between what we expected and what we actually experience can even cause us to question our faith and hope. Perhaps that is why one of the greatest gifts the church can offer is simply this: we can love one another in the fog. When someone we love is struggling, our instinct is often to fix it. We want to provide the right answer, explain the difficult circumstance, resolve the theological question, or somehow hurry them back into clarity. But love doesn’t always hurry.

Paul tells us in 1 Corinthians 13 that “love is patient.” That means we can patiently walk beside people who are questioning. We can love people who don’t have everything figured out. We can make room for someone who is wrestling with God without treating their struggle as a problem we must immediately solve. Faith matters. Hope matters. But Paul reminds us that “the greatest of these is love.” Sometimes people don’t need us to explain away the fog. They simply need to know they won’t have to walk through it alone.
