Grace and Truth Walk Together (Part 2)

This article continues our reflection on Dudley Rutherford's keynote message from last week's Pepperdine Harbor Conference. While the first article focused on the importance of God's truth as our moral compass, Rutherford also reminded his audience that biblical truth must always be accompanied by biblical grace. Jesus's ministry never sacrificed one for the other.

John describes Jesus as being "full of grace and truth" (John 1:14). Those two qualities were never in competition. Truth revealed God's standard, while grace invited people to be transformed by it. The Church is called to reflect that same balance today. If we emphasize truth without grace, we risk becoming harsh and unapproachable. If we emphasize grace without truth, we may leave people unchanged. Biblical love refuses both extremes. It speaks honestly about sin while extending the mercy that every sinner—including ourselves—desperately needs.

Perhaps that is why Paul reminds us that "love rejoices with the truth" and "always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres" (1 Corinthians 13:6-7). Genuine love does not ignore God's commands, nor does it give up on people who have wandered from them. Instead, it patiently points others toward the hope found in Jesus Christ. May our congregation always be a place where people encounter both the truth that sets them free and the grace that welcomes them home. After all, that is exactly how our Savior has loved us.
