## “Embodying Love”

A couple of weeks ago I shared a few thoughts from Jessica Hooten Wilson's keynote address at the Pepperdine Bible Lectures. Reflecting on 1 Corinthians 13, she reminded listeners that to understand love, we must look to Jesus. She then took the discussion a step further.

Wilson observed that much of our daily decision-making is centered on ourselves. Even when opportunities to serve arise, we often find ourselves asking questions like: "How will this affect me?" or "What will this cost me?" In contrast, she pointed to the example of Martin Luther King Jr., who taught that love asks a different question: "What will happen to them if I do not help?"

That shift changes everything. The love described in Scripture is not merely an emotion. It is a way of life. It moves toward people. It serves. It sacrifices. It refuses to keep score. It seeks the good of others even when doing so is inconvenient.

Wilson also shared the story of a Christian woman who endured tremendous loss and suffering, yet chose to pour her life into serving others rather than becoming consumed by bitterness. Her example served as a reminder that God's love is often most visible in ordinary acts of faithfulness, humility, and service. Jesus commanded His disciples, "Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another" (John 13:34). The world may define love in many different ways, but Christ gives us a clearer picture. Love is not merely something we feel. It is something we practice. May we learn to follow His example and walk in the way of love.

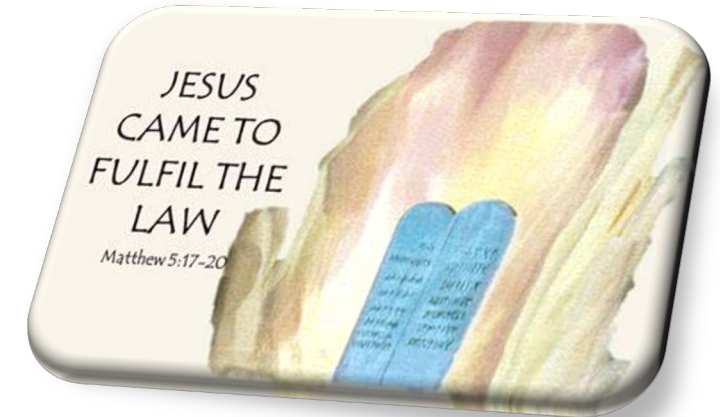
