Robert Munger (1911-2001) was a California native and spent much of his career here. “Born in Santa Cruz, Munger earned degrees from UC Berkeley and Princeton Theological Seminary.” Munger worked as a minister in churches all over CA until he found his way to Fuller Theological Seminary and “began teaching evangelism and church renewal...where an endowed chair was named in his honor.” Munger is probably best known for his 1954 sermon entitled, “My Heart, Christ’s Home” in which he describes inviting Christ into the home of his heart.

Journalist Myrna Oliver summarizes the experience, writing: “As host, Munger describes leading Christ through the figurative library, dining room, drawing room, workshop, rumpus room and locked secret closet of his heart. The guest helps the host sweep away all the clutter keeping him from being a good Christian--trashy literature, worldly goods and gluttonous fare, unsavory friendships and sleazy amusements, ineptness and old hatreds. At the end of the sermon, the grateful host signs over the title of his heart/home to his guest for safekeeping and vows to remain with Christ "as houseboy and friend.""

It’s easy to be reminded that we’re all in need of a good cleaning. We all need assistance identifying and eliminating the things in this world that are toxic and deadly. Once extracted, we also need help keeping those very same things away, the things that plague us like sicknesses. From a biblical perspective, it’s very important to recognize that humanity cannot do this alone. We are all broken/unclean/sick from sin (Rom.3:23), and we need to be cured. As Jesus tells us in Matthew 9, he is the cure! It is through Jesus that we are called to repentance in order to experience the healing & life-giving power of God. This week, let’s remember that we’re all burdened with the sickness of sin, but because of Jesus we now have a cure!
