Do I Really Want Jesus’ Help?

Most of us know when we need help. We need help when the marriage is struggling. When the money is tight. When we’re worried about our children/grandchildren . When we’re lonely, overwhelmed, afraid, or simply tired of carrying what we’ve been carrying. And don’t misunderstand where I’m going...Jesus certainly cares about those things.

But when Jesus encountered Matthew, He didn’t walk up to the tax booth and ask, “What can I do to make your life better?” He said, “Follow me” (Matthew 9:9). That’s different. Maybe the question isn’t simply whether I believe Jesus can help me. Maybe the question is whether I’m willing to let Jesus decide what kind of help I actually need. Because sometimes I want Jesus to change my circumstances when He wants to change me. I want relief. He wants surrender. I want Him to fix what is making me uncomfortable. He may want to confront what I’ve become comfortable with.

That may help us understand Jesus’ strange response later in the story: “It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick” (v.12). A good physician doesn’t simply give the patient whatever the patient asks for. He identifies what is actually wrong and begins treating it. And Jesus isn’t just a good physician; He’s THE Great Physician. So maybe the difficult question isn’t, “Do I need Jesus’ help?” Most of us would quickly say yes. The harder question is: Do I want Jesus’ help—even when His help means following Him somewhere I would not have chosen to go?

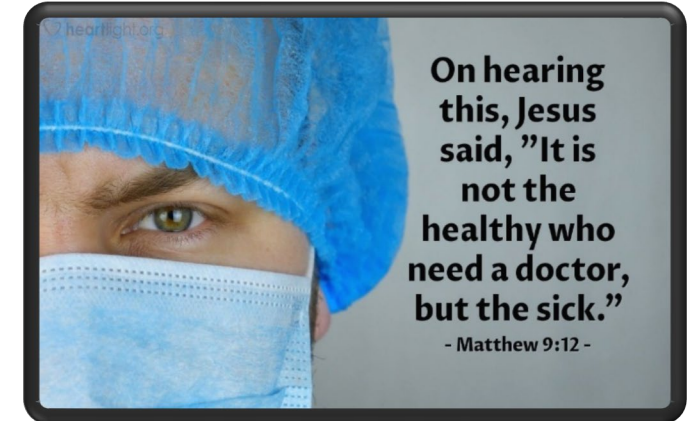
