FIVE SHOCKING TRUTHS THAT BRING YOU JOY

1. JOY IS HERE

“That night there were shepherds staying in the fields nearby, guarding their flocks of sheep. Suddenly, an angel of the Lord appeared among them, and the radiance of the Lord’s glory surrounded them” (Luke 2:8-9 NLT).

2. JOY IS SENT

“They were terrified, but the angel reassured them. ‘Don’t be afraid!’ he said. ‘I bring you good news that will bring great joy to all the people. The savior – yes, the Messiah, the Lord – has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David! And you will recognize Him by this sign: You will find a baby wrapped snugly in strips of cloth, lying in a manger’” (Luke 2:10-12 NLT).

“After seeing Him, the shepherds told everyone what had happened and what the angel had said to them about this Child. All who heard the shepherds’ story were astonished” (Luke 2:17-18 NLT).

3. JOY IS A JOURNEY

“When they saw the star, they were filled with joy!” (Matthew 2:10 NLT).

“You will grieve, but your grief will turn to joy” (John 16:20 NIV).

4. JOY IS FRIGHTENING

“Then Simeon blessed them and he said to Mary, the Baby’s mother, ‘This Child is destined to cause many in Israel to fall, but He will be a joy to many others’” (Luke 2:34 NLT).

5. JOY IS A DIFFICULT CHOICE
