

## **HOW GOD SEES YOU**

*“Your eyes are windows into your body. If you open your eyes wide in wonder and belief, your body fills up with light” (Matthew 6:22 MSG).*

*“I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which He has called you, the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints, and His incomparably great power for us who believe” (Ephesians 1:18-19 NIV).*

### **HOW GOD SEES ME BECAUSE OF HIS GRACE**

#### **1. God Sees You as ACCEPTABLE**

*“Jesus treated us much better than we deserve. He made us acceptable to God and gave us the hope of eternal life” (Titus 3:7 CEV).*

*“God saved us – not because we were good enough to be saved, but because of His kindness and grace – by washing away our sins...all because of what Jesus Christ our Savior did, so that He could declare us good in God’s eyes” (Titus 3:5-7 LB).*

*“You have been chosen by God Himself” (1 Peter 2:9 LB).*

*“Even if my mother and father forsake me, the Lord will receive me” (Psalm 27:10 NIV).*

#### **2. God Sees You as VALUABLE**

*“Look at the birds. They don’t need to plant or harvest or put food in barns because God feeds them. And you are far more valuable to Him than any birds!” (Luke 12:24 NLT).*

*“You belong to God...” (1 John 4:4 NIV).*

*“You have been bought and paid for by Christ, so you belong to Him” (1 Corinthians 7:23 LB).*

*“God says, ‘You are precious to Me’” (Isaiah 43:4 GN).*

#### **3. God Sees You as LOVABLE**

*“For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life” (John 3:16 NIV).*

*“‘The mountains and hills may crumble, but My love for you will never end’; so says the Lord who loves you” (Isaiah 54:10 GN).*

#### **4. God Sees You as FORGIVABLE**

*“Long ago, even before He made the world, God chose us to be His very own through what Christ would do for us; He decided then to make us holy in His eyes, without a single fault – we who stand before Him covered with His love” (Ephesians 1:4 LB).*

*“I am the God who forgives your sins, and I do this because of who I am. I will not hold your sins against you” (Isaiah 43:25 GN).*

#### **5. God Sees You as CAPABLE**

*“The capacity we have comes from God; it is He who made us capable of serving the new covenant...” (2 Corinthians 3:5-6 TEV).*
