HOW DO I LET JESUS RESCUE ME?

1. Admit That I Need Rescuing

“I am in deep trouble, Lord! Rush to my aid, for only You can help and save me” (Psalm 70:5 LB).

“I’m a mess! I’m nothing and have nothing: make something of me! You can do it; You’ve got what it takes, God” (Psalm 40:17 MSG).

“You rescue those who are humble” (Psalm 18:27 NLT).

2. Admit I Can’t Save Myself

“I stand silently before the Lord, waiting for You to rescue me. For salvation comes from You alone” (Psalm 62:1 LB).

“There’s no such thing as self-rescue, pulling yourself up by your bootstraps. The cost of rescue is beyond our means” (Psalm 49:7-8 MSG).

3. Ask Jesus to Save Me

“When you call on Me, I will answer; I will be with you in your trouble and I will rescue you” (Psalm 91:15 NLT).

“Anyone who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved” (Romans 10:13 LB).

4. Commit My Life to Him

“I commit my spirit into Your hands. Rescue me, Lord, for You are a faithful God!” (Psalm 31:5 NLT).
