THE MIRACLE OF MERCY Part 2: God's Mercy and My Failures

What Causes our Failures? 3 Things Peter Did Wrong

1. We Overestimate Our Strength

"Peter declared, 'Even if everyone else deserts You, I never will'" (Matthew 26:33 NLT).

"Be careful. If you are thinking, 'Oh, I would never behave like that' – let this be a warning to you. For you, too, may fall into sin'" (1 Corinthians 10:12 LB).

2. We Fear the Disapproval of Others

"Peter followed him at a distance, right up to the courtyard of the high priest...Those standing there went up to Peter and said, 'Surely you are one of them; your accent gives you away.' Then he began to call down curses, and swore to them, 'I don't know the man!'" (Matthew 26:58, 73-34 NIV).

3. We Speak Without Thinking

"Peter began to curse and swear. 'I don't even know the man!' he said. And immediately the cock crowed" Matthew 26:74 LB).

What Should We Do When We Fail? 3 Things Peter Did Right

1. Grieve

"And immediately the cock crowed. Then Peter remembered...And he went away, crying bitterly" (Matthew 26:75 LB).

"My sacrifice is a humble spirit, O God; You will not reject a humble and repentant heart" (Psalm 51:17 GN).

2. Find Support

(Easter Morning): "(Mary Magdalene) went and found the disciples, who were grieving and weeping" (Mark 16:10 NLT).

"A week later the disciples were together again... (John 20:26 LB).

3. Cast Yourself on God's Mercy

"Because of His great mercy, He gave us new life by raising Jesus Christ from the dead. This fills us with a living hope" (1 Peter 1:3 GN).

"Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7 NIV).

What Does Jesus Do with Our Failures?

1. He Is Not Shocked

"God certainly knows what we are made of. He bears in mind that we are dust" (Psalm 103:14 GW).

2. He Prays for Us

"And so He is able, now and always, to save those who come to God through Him, because He lives forever to plead with God for them" (Hebrews 7:25 GN).

3. He Believes in Us

"And when you have turned back to Me again, strengthen your brothers" (Luke 22:32 NIV).

4. He Shows Us Mercy When We Are Down

"The Lord's unfailing love and mercy still continue, fresh as the morning, as sure as the sunrise" (Lamentations 3:22-23 GN).

5. He Uses Our Failures to Build His Church

"So, when you have repented and turned to Me again, strengthen and build up the faith of your brothers" (Luke 22:32 LB).
