MERCY: Undeserved Forgiveness and Unearned Kindness

1. MERCY MEANS GOD FORGIVES ME

• God WANTS to forgive me

"You are a God of forgiveness, always ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to become angry, and full of love and mercy" (Nehemiah 9:17b LB).

"You do not stay angry forever, but delight to show mercy" (Micah 7:18b NIV).

• God FREELY forgives me.

"All of us have sinned...yet now God declares us 'not guilty' of offending Him if we trust in Jesus Christ, who freely takes away our sins" (Romans 3:23-24 LB).

• God IMMEDIATELY forgives me.

"God is merciful and quick to forgive" (Isaiah 55:7b TEV).

• God COMPLETELY forgives me.

"... God forgave all our sins. He cancelled the record that contained the charges against us. He took it and destroyed it by nailing it to Christ's cross" (Colossians 2:13-14 NLT).

"You will have mercy on us again; You will conquer our sins. You will throw away all our sins into the deepest part of the sea" (Micah 7:19 NCV).
