





Pastor Ryan's favorite Advent Bible study, written by the author J. Ellsworth Kalas, presents new insight into the biblical story of Christmas.


Kalas approaches the season through the "back side"--through a unique starting point, a creative retelling, a new "lens," or the eyes of a minor character.


