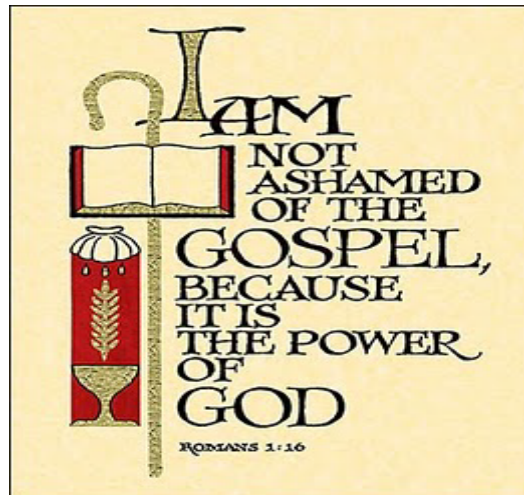

PASTOR TIMOTHY OSWALD
CAPT. CHC, USN (Ret.)

Pastor George Lottich baptized Timothy Oswald and welcomed him into the
Lord’s family on September 17, 1961, at Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church in

Chicago, Illinois. Growing up in Addison, IL, Pastor Oswald attended St. Paul's Lutheran Church and School in Addison, where he was confirmed in 1974.

Pastor Oswald graduated from Wheaton College in 1984 with a Bachelor of Arts in Biblical and Religious Studies. He also holds a Master of Divinity from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, a Master of Military Studies from the Marine Corps Command and Staff College, a Master of Theology in Systematic Theology from Trinity International University, and a Doctor of Ministry in Military Ministries from Concordia Seminary, St. Louis.

Pastor interned at Abiding Word Lutheran Church in Deshler, NE and Faith Lutheran Church in Fairbury, NE. He was ordained as a minister by The American Assn. of Lutheran Churches (TAALC) and accepted his first call to Living Word Lutheran Church of Windom, MN in 1992. TAALC then endorsed him for extended ministry as a chaplain in the US Navy. He received his commission in 1994. He and his family formerly attended Hope Lutheran Church in Virginia Beach, VA. Chaplain Oswald transferred to the clergy roster of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod in 2013.

He most recently served as Force Chaplain for Commander, Naval Surface Forces Atlantic. Prior to that, he served as Force Chaplain for Commander, Submarine Forces Atlantic. He was Command Chaplain on USS Iwo Jima. He has also served with Commander, Strike Fighter Wing Atlantic in Virginia Beach, VA; Multi-National Corps Iraq; Naval Air Station Oceana; USS Harry S. Truman; 3d Battalion 3d Marines, First Radio Battalion, and Marine Corps Base Hawaii.

He retired from the Navy in 2016, at which time he was called to be Pastor of Hope Lutheran Church, Twin Lakes, WI, where he has served faithfully for the past 10 years.

Pastor Oswald and his wife Dawn were married in 1986. God has blessed them with four children: Melissa (Josh) Walton of Elkhorn, WI; Nathan Oswald of Richmond, IL; Bethany Wirtz of Tucson, AZ; and Melanie (Alex) Clarke of Apex, North Carolina, and nine grandchildren.
