

# LEADER JOB DESCRIPTIONS

## A. ALL VOLUNTEERS

- Pray for the kids attending VBS and their families
- Participate in training and planning sessions
- Participate in Celebration events.

## B. CLASSROOM LEADER\*\*

- Assign specific tasks to assistant teachers and teen helpers
- Take attendance, collect name tags at dismissal, rotate with kids, and ensure all kids are accounted for at all times
- Reach out to parents of children who indicate they do not have a church home
- Communicate any important information, daily, with parents of children at pickup
- Obtain needed supplies or let directors know of needs

## D. CLASSROOM GUIDES

- Work with your team to decorate assigned Bible Study Room to fit the theme
- Move with children to each VBS Rotation site
- Be familiar with each day's Bible story, Bible verse, and life application
- Assist Lead Teacher during rotations and worship rally
- Help ensure that children are released to the appropriate adult

## E. BIBLE STORY TEAM \*\*

- Work with your team to decorate assigned Bible Study Room to fit the theme
- Lead the Bible Study sessions
- Obtain needed supplies or let directors know of needs

## F. ROTATION TEAM

- Be familiar with Bible story, Bible verse, and Today's Point for each day.
- Assume responsibility for the cleanup of the site daily and at the end of VBS week.
- Decorate the site to support the theme.
- Obtain needed supplies or let directors know of needs

**Note:** Everyone that will have contact with the kids during VBS must have a background check (no cost to you.)

- \*\*All Team Leads/Bible Story Teachers must be LSC members.
- \*\*\*Student helpers- ages 12-13 must work with an adult at all times.
