- 1) An Address to God

 1 How long, Lord?
- 2) Description of the Complaint
 - ¹ How long, Lord? Will you forget me forever? How long will you hide your face from me?
 - ² How long must I wrestle with my thoughts and day after day have sorrow in my heart? How long will my enemy triumph over me?

3) Request for God's Help

³ Look on me and answer, Lord my God. Give light to my eyes, or I will sleep in death,

4) Expression of Trust in God

⁵ But I trust in your unfailing love; my heart rejoices in your salvation.

⁶ I will sing the Lord's praise, for he has been good to me.
