

Hume Lake Summer Camps General Info

DEPARTURE: Students will arrive in the south parking lot of the church at 7:30 AM on Sunday, August 12. We will leave promptly once the bus is loaded.

LUGGAGE: Each student may bring a single piece of soft luggage such as a duffel bag, and a sleeping bag / pillow. Additionally, students may have a carry-on item such as a backpack.

RETURN: We will leave from the camp around 9:00 AM on Saturday, August 18, and should return to the church parking lot between 3:00 and 4:00 PM depending on traffic. Campers may call parents with our expected time of arrival.
