Day 1: The World-Wide Global Methodist Church

Hebrews 2:12: He says, "I will declare Your Name to my brothers and sisters; in the assembly (church) I will sing Your praises."

1 Corinthians 10:32: Do not cause anyone to stumble, whether Jews, Greeks, or the church of God.

Faithful God, You have called us to deliver the good news of Your salvation to all the earth. Please bless the Global Methodist Church as we expand this mission around the world and declare the truth of Your Scriptures.

Day 2: Sandia Fellowship Global Methodist Church

Psalms 27:4: One thing I ask from the Lord, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and to seek Him in His temple.

Lord, You invited us to form a new congregation and have guided us in every step of our growth. We pray that You continue to uphold Sandia Fellowship Global Methodist Church in Your hand as we move forward in our mission.

Day 3: Our New Church Buildings

Leviticus 26:11-12: I will put My dwelling place among you, and I will not abhor you. I will walk among you, and I will be your God and you will be My people.

Day 6: Interior Designer and Furnishings

1 Kings 6:18,21: The inside of the Temple was cedar, carved with gourds and open flowers. Everything was cedar, no stone was to be seen. -Solomon covered the inside of the Temple with pure gold.

1 Kings 7:51: So all the work that King Solomon did for the house of the Lord was finished. Then Solomon brought in the things his father had dedicated – the silver, the gold, and the vessels- and he placed them in the treasuries of the house of the Lord.

Holy Lord, we pray Your blessing on the important work of our interior designer. We understand that this step emphasizes the completion of construction and begins the transformation of our building into a sanctified dwelling. May each component of the interior bring a sense of peace, worship and reverence. Thanks be to God!
