Could Cost Us Everything

I was recently reminded by the incredible Christian scholar R.L. Solberg that we always need to be ready and willing to do whatever it takes for Jesus. In John chapter 11, we learn about the death and resurrection of Lazarus. But before Jesus goes back to Judea where Lazarus has died, we need to look at the end of the prior chapter to see why this was so significant. In John 10:30 Jesus says, "I




and the Father are one." This prompts the Jews to pick up stones to kill him for blasphemy, for claiming that he was God. But before they could kill him Jesus gets away.

Shortly after this Jesus is told about Lazarus' demise; He waits two days and tells His disciples, "Let us go to Judea again." Jesus proceeds without fear. The disciples in disbelief say, "Rabbi, the Jews were just now seeking to stone You, and You are going there again?" Thomas the twin, (who we know colloquially as "Doubting Thomas") said to his fellow disciples, "Let us go, that we may die with Him." So

Thomas is doubting that Jesus will survive this visit and yet is so committed that he is willing to go with Him and die with Him. He encourages the others that they should all go and lay down their lives for Jesus.

Thomas demonstrates a model of discipleship that we sometimes miss today and that's that following Jesus isn't always safe. It's sometimes dangerous and risky. Sometimes it can cost us everything. Just recently we have seen the persecution of Christians across the globe and especially in Africa. In the USA it can be easy to take for granted our religious freedom. But we see that Thomas is calling us to a courageous faith – wherever Jesus goes I will follow. Jesus is worth so much more than this world and He is the One who laid down His life for our sakes.




