The Latest Building Update

Hopefully with that title I have the attention of all of you who are wondering about the slow progress on the renovation of our church property. Many of you like me have been frustrated regarding the building renovation and that it feels like we are moving along "as slow as molasses in January." I get it. I had no idea that ten months after purchasing our property that we wouldn't be further along in the renovation process.



Here is the latest update and it isn't what you are expecting. Some of you will believe what I am about to say, and others will be skeptical. During one of my early morning walks this last week, I was again wrestling with the Lord over the lack of progress regarding our property. Here is the impression that I got. Basically, I sensed the Lord communicating to me that I/we are not paying attention to the supernatural and spiritual realities regarding the furthering of the

establishment of our ministry in its future location.

The Lord then reminded me of the basics of Ephesians 6 and that we are wrestling not against flesh and blood, but against principalities and spiritual forces of darkness working against the calling that is upon our church. This is a "turf war" of sorts and basically the Lord impressed upon me that until we as a church engage the enemy on the field of battle through prayer, that there will be no significant breakthrough experienced moving forward any time soon. However, with prayer and faith all things are possible.

Thankfully in the Lord's timing, this morning (Monday) I had a meeting with my coach who has had plenty of experience leading several churches through prayer strategies to overcome building obstacles. Obviously, there is "nothing new under the sun" when it comes to churches facing spiritual battles while making advances. Therefore, I am working on several layers of prayer strategies that I am not going to detail in this article. Some will potentially involve everyone, while other strategies involve certain groups of people. I'll have more details later.

Here is one strategy that I want to get started today and everyone can participate in. Praying about this whole matter, I was drawn to Mark 9 where Jesus' disciples couldn't drive out a demon. Jesus replied as recorded in verse 29, "This kind can come out only by prayer." Some translations add "...and fasting." Here is what I am asking everyone to do for at least the next 30 days (may renew if needed). Set your alarm for either 9:29 a.m. or 9:29 p.m. and pause to pray over this passage and pray for a breakthrough and aggressive advancement on the completion of our building. If you want to fast from something and "Supersize" your prayers that would be great.


