
LOCATION CHANGE FOR THIS SUNDAY, AUGUST 10

A Perspective Reset

I mentioned in last Sunday's message that at the end of July I had finished five years serving as an Albuquerque Police Chaplain. It has been an incredible experience working with an amazing staff of volunteers and getting to meet and serve with a great variety of those who work with the Albuquerque Police Department. All those with whom I had the pleasure to work and serve with in the APD I experienced as courageous, compassionate, and very disciplined. I am so thankful for those who are called to serve in our community in one of the toughest jobs that I have ever witnessed.



While I am going to miss serving with the fellow chaplains and those who serve in a variety of levels of the APD, there is another blessing that came with serving as a chaplain that I am going to have to replace in some way. Serving as a chaplain, I encountered people who not only were experiencing the worst of family tragedies related to the unexpected death of a loved one, but I was regularly exposed to people living in what appeared to me to be some of the most difficult and depressing living conditions.

Countless times I would be finishing a call out to a scene and then be driving home thanking the Lord for the incredibly blessed life that I have. Serving people in need in those circumstances repeatedly reset my perspective on life. I needed that. We all need a perspective reset in life. Here's the key question. Where are you serving others where God can regularly reset your perspective on life? This is one of the reasons that it is more blessed to give than receive. The regular giving of our time, effort, gifts and resources opens a door to encounters with Jesus and the blessings of the Kingdom of God like nothing else.

Do you have a "Perspective Reset" ministry in your life? If not, why not? What are you waiting for? Are you willing to pray and ask the Lord to open that door?

Pray that we would take Father, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit into the prison so that lives would be changed, His love would be made known, and everyone would be drawn into a closer relationship with Jesus.

The Sandia Fellowship Women's Breakfast group is again collecting gently used purses and new toiletries for Pursonalities Plus ABQ for distribution to deserving women in our community.

We are collecting:

- Personal items such as toothbrushes and toothpaste, deodorant, soap, shampoo, brush and comb, hairspray, mirror, hand cream, hand sanitizer, lip balm, lipstick and makeup

Pursonalities Plus ABQ is a program that provides purses to women in various programs: victims of domestic violence, sex trafficking, homelessness, sexual assault, and incarceration. Since 2016, the organization has collected, filled and distributed 11,469 purses! Currently the program gifts purses to 35 groups such as A Peaceful Habitation, Barrett House, CareNet Pregnancy Center, Family Promise, Joy Junction, SAFE House, and many others.


