

the progress as we work toward finishing this vital building project.




of Giving cards are an opportunity to express our gratitude to God and generosity in supporting Sandia Fellowship in our call to make disciples of Jesus Christ.

Cost is \$25 and children are free.




Update from SE Coleman Missionary to Guatemala and Africa

The following is an excerpt from SE Coleman's recent newsletter

Howdy!! Oops, was in Texas three weeks, rodeo and visits! I sit here back in Guatemala to finish 2025 that has held so much. It promises to be eventful right to Dec 31. As you might remember, last newsletter in July, mentioned that I was going to Patagonia. Yes, I did!! Was in Chile and Argentina right down to "Del fin de Mundo." Ushuaia, Argentina became one of my favorite places in the world. It was the tail end of winter. I could talk the entire newsletter about all the places I went, sites I saw and people I met. You know when you go anywhere, ALL of you is present, the memories, the joy and the pain you carry. There were many high moments as I saw history, and dolphins and snow!! God just provided for me in some amazing ways. It was so "affirming." We are NEVER away from Him and He from us. Hallelujah!!

In coming back to Guatemala, there are plans for finishing this year. 25 years ago I started giving away sweaters end of November, start of December. It has been such a blessing over the years. Already, I have talked to Telma, Olga Lorena, even Billy to be involved. We'll start buying warm clothing of all sizes, get them clean and organized to just look early in the mornings to give away. We load up early and see people with no warm clothing and believe me, it does get "cold" here and if you are out early with no extra sweater or coat, you are shivering. We have so many stories over the years of gratitude, thanksgiving. It's hard to forget a little group of children walking together, the oldest being no more than 9, at 6 in the morning, school is out and they were going to buy their daily bread. We outfitted all of them and they were just so overjoyed. Another year we saw a sweet old couple with no sweaters and they cried when we stopped and helped them. We are going to take little Ohana. Of course, she is young, but we want to instill in her that blessing of giving. She is such an imitator!!

In December, there are gift baskets we put together for Christmas and this is a blessing to many families. We always have a few extra to give as God directs us. Two years ago, we were looking for the house of one family and for some reason could not find. We saw two women had been talking, 1 walked away, THIS was the stop God wanted for us. We found out the two women had never received gift baskets at Christmas and we ended up giving to both, driving one across town to her place with the big basket. I bought toys for all the kids in one of those families. Telma and I de-livered, sat on concrete teaching the oldest how to play Uno!


BUILDING OUR FUTURE - BIG UPDATE!


