A Weed Wacker Witness

We have a number of members who have helped us this summer and fall with the maintenance our church property by weed eating, spraying and general cleaning. However, we have one member who had an interesting interaction last Saturday with one of our neighbors which led me to think of this encounter as a "Weed Wacker Witness."



Whenever Hovey Corbin is working on our property, I often get updated text messages on the progress and challenges along the way which are quite interesting. Here is a portion of one of those messages.

Aloha John, [Hovey spent years working in Hawaii]

It has been an interesting and productive day in the north parking lot. I was going to help my son-in-law work on his new gate at their house on Vallecitos Rd., but it had been a steady rain at their house, so I

changed gears and went back to church and attacked the north parking lot again. I used up the 50 feet of vinyl coated wire, so I loaded up the spool on my weed eater with the plastic trimmer string I had in my truck, and I worked my way toward the northeast corner of the parking lot.

As I got close to the northeast corner, a nice young man came out of the sign company and put some trash in their dumpster. I waved to him and kept on weed eating. He came back with more trash, and I stopped to talk with him. His name is Casey Pruit (owner/manager of Aspect Signs & Wraps). As we stood by his dumpster, I saw that there were several huge goat head plants growing up against the metal fence at the front of the business. I had my Sawzall with the carbide tooth 12" saw blade in it, and I told Casey that I could easily remove the huge goat head plants that were growing wild by the metal fence.


In summary, Hovey and Casey worked together to help clean up part of the growth on Casey's property. Hovey then continues,

That second invitation was a result of Hovey simply asking Casey, "Do you have a church home?" It's not a hard question, but one that we just need to be reminded to ask others who may not have a church home but who might respond positively to an invitation (or multiple invitations). I appreciate Hovey's concern and willingness to ask the question -- and may we all follow the lead of this "Weed Wacker Witness."




