

Didn't See That Coming!

Sunday afternoon I was driving home after a couple of hospital visits and was able to start listening to the live broadcast of the memorial service for Charlie Kirk. I managed to connect to the broadcast about the time Secretary Marco Rubio was talking. I was a little surprised when he closed his comments with a basic outline of the message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.



When I arrived home, Lindy had the TV on and was watching the memorial service and I heard several more presentations of the message of salvation through Jesus Christ. What surprised me was that this entire service was presented without commercials on ABC! When was the last time ABC broadcasted a Special Report that contained repeated presentations of the message of saving faith through Jesus Christ? I can't recall and I sure didn't see that coming!


The person that many of us were most eager to hear from during this

memorial service was Charlie's wife, Erika. She shared her memories, encouragements and commitment to further the mission of Turning Point USA into the future which was amazing to watch. However, when she shared her decision to forgive the man who killed her husband -- that was an amazing expression and witness to the grace of God. This was probably not expected given that it was only less than two weeks when Charlie's life was taken.

I mentioned in my message a couple of Sundays ago about the comparisons between Charlie and Stephen, the first martyr of the New Testament Church. Both Stephen and Charlie were about the same age. Both were brilliant communicators with an in-depth knowledge of the Scriptures. Both died outdoors in a public setting where they faced supporters and adversaries. Both died almost instantly.

In my opinion, when Erika spoke about her forgiving the man who killed her husband and quoted the words of Jesus and Stephen saying, "Forgive them Lord, for they do not know what they do," she in my estimation completed that similarity between her husband and Stephen. She not only communicated the saving message of Jesus, but she also released it demonstrably through forgiveness. It is estimated that the total viewership through all forms of media surpassed 100 million. I didn't see any of that coming! What a witness and yet what a price to pay. Love is costly and is amazing when seen and experienced.

MESSAGE FOR THIS SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 28 "Faith: Dead, Demonic, or Dynamic"

James 2:14-26

This Sunday we are continuing in our series on the Book of James, "Faith Works." In this second half of chapter two, James divides one's faith into three categories of either being Dead, Demonic or Dynamic. The title of this sermon reflects the bluntness of James in his description of a believer's faith or lack of faith. James also uses some great illustrations of dynamic faith found in a famous patriarch and a prostitute. This portion of James summarizes the theme of the entire letter and is also historically one of the more controversial chapters in the Bible.
